Bench Dedication Terms & Conditions

Dedicating a park bench is a meaningful way to honour the memory of family or friends while creating a personal connection with the park.

The benches enhance the visitor experience providing a welcome respite for walkers and a place for quiet reflection.

1. From time to time a new bench will be installed in the park and offered to the community for dedication. Available opportunities will be advertised on our website.

2. The benches will remain the property of Golden Valley Tree Park Inc. or DBCA (Department of Conservation and Attractions) and may be dedicated to individuals by the public.
3. Information regarding bench locations and costs of the dedication will be available by contacting the Park Management Committee. Pricing will vary, based on the cost of the bench and installation and include a fundraising contribution to support the park's ongoing care. Contact addresses below.
4. To maintain a uniform aesthetic of signage at GVTP the committee will provide and install a standard brass plaque (typically 150mm x 40mm). Inscription text must be approved by the committee; no religious text is permitted. The cost of engraving will be added to the final price once a formal quote is obtained.
5. The park will provide basic maintenance and minor repairs, if needed. Donors are welcome to assist with cleaning, applying protective oil (no paint), polishing the plaque, and some repairs. Please contact the committee before undertaking any work.
6. Our park benches are made of wood and exposed to the elements; while they are built to last many years, their lifespan is limited. If a bench deteriorates beyond repair or becomes a safety concern, it will be removed and the dedication period will conclude.
7. While bench locations are intended to be permanent, the park reserves the right to relocate a bench for management or safety reasons. In such cases, we will make every effort to notify the donor.
